Application Requirements:

Complete applications must be mail to Jeff Milano-Johnson Fund c/o M. Milano, 214 Woodland Road, Pittsford, NY 14534 and postmarked by May 14, 2009. **A completed application must include: a statement from the applicant, two letters of references one from a school official (teacher, coach, principal) including an attestation and another attestation from parent/guardian. Letters of reference must come from someone other than a relative or guardian.**

Eligibility:

The application will be open to any boy or girl section V lacrosse player who is a senior and who meets the specified criteria.

Criteria:

The applicant must demonstrate the following criteria: enthusiasm for life, perseverance, compassion, service to others and creativity mixed with a touch of goofiness.

Applicant grade point average must be 2.5 or higher; applicant must have followed all the rules, regulations and procedures of his/her School District.

Applicants must submit a completed application packet which includes:

- the completed application form with a personal statement
- two references one from a school official (teacher, coach, principal...)
- the school official who writes the reference must complete an attestation statement
- a parent's/guardian's attestation form

References from a relative or family member are not permissible.

Preference will be given to applicants who have submitted a letter of recommendation from an individual who has been positively affected by the applicant e.g. a community or activity sponsor, employer, minister, teacher, peer or friend.

Special consideration will be given to an applicant who demonstrates financial need.

It is not necessary, although it is desired, to award the scholarship each year.

Selection Committee:

The selection committee will be comprised of five individuals chosen by the Jeff Milano-Johnson Fund Administrators.
