Scholarship Description

Name of Scholarship: HARVEY E. ANDERSON SCHOLARSHIP

Donor Information: Established in 1987 by Harvey E. Anderson, former president of the Rochester Coca-Cola Bottling Company and long time supporter of local sports activities, to reward young people's good citizenship, self-motivation, achievement and concern for others.

Purpose of Scholarship: To be awarded annually to students who participate in Section V sports, have been diligent in academic and athletic endeavors, and exhibit self-motivation and extraordinary effort.

Number and Size of Awards: One renewable award of \$1,500 each to a boy and a girl. One *non-renewable* award of \$1,500 each to a boy and a girl runner-up.

Allowed Use of Award: Educational expenses of higher education.

Eligibility Criteria: College-bound graduating seniors who have participated in athletics at Section V schools. Each school in Section V may select one boy and one girl to complete the application. Applicants need not be the best natural athletes or scholars, but should demonstrate 110% effort in studies and chosen sports. Financial need may be considered, but is not a determining factor.

Application Process: Information about the scholarship is updated and posted on the Section V website (www.sectionv.org) in October. Each school in Section V identifies two applicants (one boy and one girl) and gives them applications to complete. Completed applications are sent to the Community Foundation in early December and reviewed by a committee comprised of members from Section V, the Rochester Press-Radio Club and Rochester Area Community Foundation. Finalists may be interviewed by the committee. Award recipients will be officially announced at the Day of Champions Dinner. Award letters are sent by the Community Foundation and the scholarships are paid in August/September to the college upon verification of recipients' matriculation in college.

Committee/Selection Process: Nomination process. Contact Guidance Counselors or Athletic Director at Section V High Schools for details.

Award Payment: Award letters are sent to the recipients with instructions on claiming the award. Payment is made to the college for the recipient's account.

Renewability: The award is renewable for up to a total of four awards. Renewal awards are made upon receipt by the Community Foundation of certification (forms provided) indicating that the recipient maintained a minimum "C" average for the just completed year and is enrolled for the coming year.
